Tips for better movement

- Move BIGGER!
- Take longer steps using bigger arm swings
- Make your letters bigger when you write
- Use more effort and bigger movements:
 - 1. Getting up from chairs or bed
 - 2. Getting dressed
 - 3. Reaching for things
 - 4. Every time you move!
- Exercise for at least 30 minutes per day! Start today!
